In 10 pages or less, address each of the following questions in sequential order (place question with number prior to your answer):

1. What is the technology/product(s) to be transitioned? Include a description and figure(s)/photo(s) if available.
2. How does your SBIR Phase II support the Ballistic Missile Defense System (BMDS)? Describe the current problem. Describe how the current problem will be resolved. (What is the value to the BMDS?)
3. What are the required exit criteria for the SBIR Phase II Enhancement Program such that the acquisition program manager/procuring organization might agree to insert this technology?
4. Describe the funding profile required to assure transition of the technology upon completion of the SBIR Phase II Enhancement Program.
5. What is the Acquisition Program Manager's/procuring organization's commitment to transition? (You must include an advocacy letter from the relevant acquisition program manager(s)/procuring organization(s) articulating their pull for this technology and commitment to insert the technology in their acquisition/sustainment program. The letter does not count towards the page count).
6. What are the risks (cost, schedule, technical, manufacturability, sustainment) to developing and transitioning the proposed technology?

Note: Failure to follow the above instructions may result in automatic rejection of your application.

Please be advised, within 45 days of Phase II Enhancement Award notification, the company and third party must certify, that the entire amount of the matching funds from the outside investor has been transferred to the company. Certification consists of a letter, signed by both the company and its outside investor, stating that "\$_____ in cash has been transferred to our company from our outside investor in accord with the MDA SBIR Phase II Enhancement procedures." The letter must be sent to the MDA contracting office along with a copy of the company's bank statement showing the funds have been deposited. If the outside investor is a non-SBIR/non-STTR DoD program, it must provide a line of accounting within the 45 days that can be accessed immediately.

IMPORTANT: If the DoD contracting office does not receive, within the 45 days, this certification showing the transfer of funds, the company will be ineligible to compete for an MDA Phase II Enhancement award unless a specific written exception is granted by the MDA SBIR program manager.

Failure to meet these conditions in their entirety and within the time frames indicated will generally disqualify a company from participation in the current MDA SBIR Phase II Enhancement process.
